<ul> <li>Run on a Friday so that people could stay on after school (approx one hour), community/social aspect as well as fund-raising.</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Would need to be near a source of electricity - near green building or main building.</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Need to work on fencing first around the childcare area, so could be launched in Autumn Term (earliest)</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>FoL to come up with some costings for some kind of free-standing self-contained structure.</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Considerations/restrictions re queueing/large groups of people?</li> <li>Would need parent volunteers to staff the Cafe.</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Suggested parent consultation to assess interest (both in attending and volunteering)</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Could be combined with 'attractants' like music being played/artwork being displayed.</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>The school already has an urn for hot drinks.</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Trial run - after school on Friday 17th September - Welcome to New Parents but open to all (ET/ND/RRR)</li> </ul>

<ul> <li>Last time a lot of people came even though they had not signed up.</li> <li>Group of parents have been growing seedlings which need to be</li> </ul>	

<ul> <li>planted ASAP.</li> <li>Could dig beds direct into ground for time being and build the raised beds at a later date. Measure out beds on Friday ready to be dug out.</li> <li>EYFS more clearing and work in Forest School as well (CS to email Fiona - to give us a list of what needs to be done), OPAL Shed, clearing sandbags</li> <li>Painting Groovy Sue's container - to be done in July? (Good Gym?)</li> <li>FOL to cover costs of buying in some pastries/fruit - Camilla to bring her pizza oven!</li> <li>Lollies!!</li> <li>JG to send around a sign up sheet tomorrow</li> </ul>

School's Update (Term 3B)</li> <li>Finalising budget for next academic year and dates (eg sports days)</li> <li>Roll for September looking good (Reception full/almost full which is good compared to city averages)</li> <li>Working on curriculum and developing SEN Charlotte SENCo from Sept)</li> <li>School Streets - lots of positive feedback but some vehemently negative feedback</li> <li>Holiday childcare will not be available until Summer 2022</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>7.Fundraising Update</li> <li>Lottery Update - 48 tickets at highest point, now 38 tickets (JG has won twice and kindly donated his winnings to FoL) - add logos to the newsletters?</li> <li>Grants Update</li> <li>£500 from Magic Little Grants for gardening equipment (CI to check any restrictions)</li> <li>grant writing team: CI/RRR/MA/Gemma Humphreys - meeting on Monday</li> <li>Danny Yee and JG exploring grant funding for an additional cycle store with a 'green roof'</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>8. Larkfest</li> <li>ET, CI and ND met on 26th May and agreed that there would not be sufficient lead time to organise Larkfest this year, given COVID restrictions.</li> </ul>

Indemnity insurance would need to be taken out by groups using the hall</li> <li>Official 'opening' of Outdoor Hall nearer end of term</li> <li>Agree date for AGM Weds 22nd September - encourage attendance</li> </ul>
